#### **Observations**

During 2020-2021 we have looked at our braille library collection to make room for new additions and remove unused/poor condition books. With the help of volunteers we have completed weeding our handicraft, adult, and cookbook collections. One of our goals for 2021 was to move to a webbased library database. This would allow fuller access to our braille collection. We chose Library Thing, a web-based database used by many small collections and non-profit libraries. Although we could import data from our old <a href="Works">Works</a> database, each record needed to be edited to our specific needs. Sue Nelson and Kathy Dorn have spent many, many hours making this migration possible and we hope to make the database available to our library users in February 2022. This is a major accomplishment. **Goals for 2022** also include eliminating all of our EBAE print/braille books and replacing classics and highly used titles with books in UEB.
